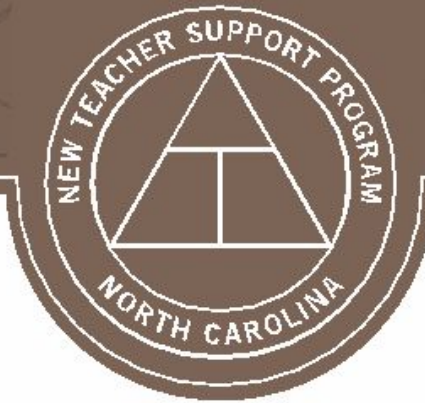


# Igniting and Inspiring Unmotivated Students

# Objective/Goal



Through strategy exploration, analyze and solve a motivation challenge with a student or group of students you work with.

# Develop Scenario



- In triads, pairs, or individually, develop a scenario and write it...
  - Who is unmotivated (student, groups of students, class)?
  - Why do you think they are not motivated?
  - What have you done to increase motivation?

# Agree/Disagree Challenge



- Read the quotes in your bag
- Assign each quote a number
  - 5 - strongly agree
  - 4 - agree
  - 3 - neutral
  - 2 - disagree
  - 1 - strongly disagree

# Agree/Disagree Challenge



- Next, at your table, think about the following questions:
  - Which quotes did you agree/disagree with strongly? Are there any variations at your table with those quotes?
  - Discuss differences and similarities at your table.

# Strategies



- 10 by 2
- Choice
- Rewards
- Make it real!
- Growth Mindset
- Specific Feedback (avoid “great job” or “this is not good.”)
- Goal-setting

# Scenario



- Create a storybird picture book to tell the story of your student (or group of students)
  - What strategy did you use to help them become more motivated?
  - How will you assess whether students are motivated or not?
